

TOWN OF CHOICELAND
BYLAW NO. 010 - 2013

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF CHOICELAND, TO RESTRICT WATER USAGE OF THE TOWN OF CHOICELAND WATER SUPPLY.

WHEREAS, the Council deems it necessary to warrant restrictions of water usage by consumers, in the Town of Choiceland, due to demand exceeding supply;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Choiceland, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The following schedule is to be observed when watering lawns and gardens:
 - a) Even numbered houses will water on even numbered calendar days, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. only.
 - b) Odd numbered houses will water on odd numbered calendar days, (with the exception of the 31st days of the months of July and August where no watering will occur) between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. only.

PENALTIES

2. Any person who contravenes any of the watering schedule restrictions shall be liable to the following penalties:
 - a) First Offence-warning by registered mail or personal service of the violation,
 - b) Second Offence-Fifty (\$50.00) dollar fine,
 - c) Third Offence and Subsequent Offence's-One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and watering privileges restricted further upon Council discretion.

REPEALED BYLAW

3. Bylaw No. 002/2011 is hereby repealed.

COMING INTO FORCE

4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect immediately.
